About the Exchange

About the Instructor Workload Exchange

- AAUDE had a similar exchange (Teaching Load Analysis) in the 1990s
- AAUDE has relied on the Delaware Cost Study to provide instructor workload information for more than 25 years, but the Study was discontinued in 2025
 - Many members felt that the required cost data was too difficult to obtain and/or not accurate enough to be useful
- The new exchange item captures instructional activity only – no cost data
- Two elements: faculty and course
 - Joined by a faculty ID key

Template Review – Faculty Data

- AAUDE institution code
- Academic Year
- Term code (currently fall only)
- School / college abbreviation
- Department name
- Faculty ID (unique per individual per department / CIP)
- Primary & Secondary CIP codes
- Instructor rank code
- Tenure Type & Track attribute codes
- Instructional staff role code (similar to IPEDS EAP categories: primarily instruction, primarily research, etc.)
- Instructor type rollup code (more general categories: regular ranks, supplemental, etc.)
- Instructor description (campus detail as needed)
- FTE
- Gender code
- Race/Ethnicity code and flags (is NRA, race unknown, Hispanic, American Indian, Asian, Black, Hawaiian, and White)

Template Review – Course Data

- AAUDE institution code
- Academic Year
- Term type code (semester or quarter)
- Term code (currently fall only)
- Faculty ID (link to the faculty data)
- Course section ID (may be listed on multiple records for co-taught sections)
- Course section level
- Course section rollup (general section type categories: regular, independent study, labs/discussion/recitation)
- Course section code & description (type of section: lecture, lab, etc.)
- Instruction mode (delivery mode: in-person, online, hybrid)
- Instructor role in course (primary, supplemental)
- Teaching percent
- Teaching enrollment count
- Teaching student credit hours
- Course title
- Cross-list count
